## Christodoulos A. Floudas Lecture – Sunday, July 1

We are dedicating **PSE 2018** to the memory of the late Professor Christodoulos A. Floudas, a giant in the field of Process Systems Engineering. When Chris passed away, our community lost a visionary leader and many of us lost a close friend. We are honoring Chris' life and legacy by establishing the Christodoulou A. Floudas Distinguished Lectureship sponsored by the Elsevier journal Computers & Chemical Engineering. Professor Arthur W. Westerberg, a true pioneer in our field and a close friend of Chris', will give the inaugural C.A. Floudas Lecture. This opening lecture will be in the Coronado Ballroom from 7:00 pm – 8:00 pm.

The weather in San Diego is Coastal. Average high is the lower 80s and average low is in the mid-70s.

## **Transportation to and from San Diego International Airport (SAN)**

The Manchester Grand Hyatt is very convenient to the San Diego airport. The airport is only 2.7 miles (about 10-15 minutes).

Because the airport is so close to the hotel, finding a taxi or Uber is easy and inexpensive. A taxi fare is approximately \$17.00 and an Uber fare approximately \$15.00 one way.

If you choose to rent a car, parking at the hotel is detailed below:

### *Valet Parking*
